

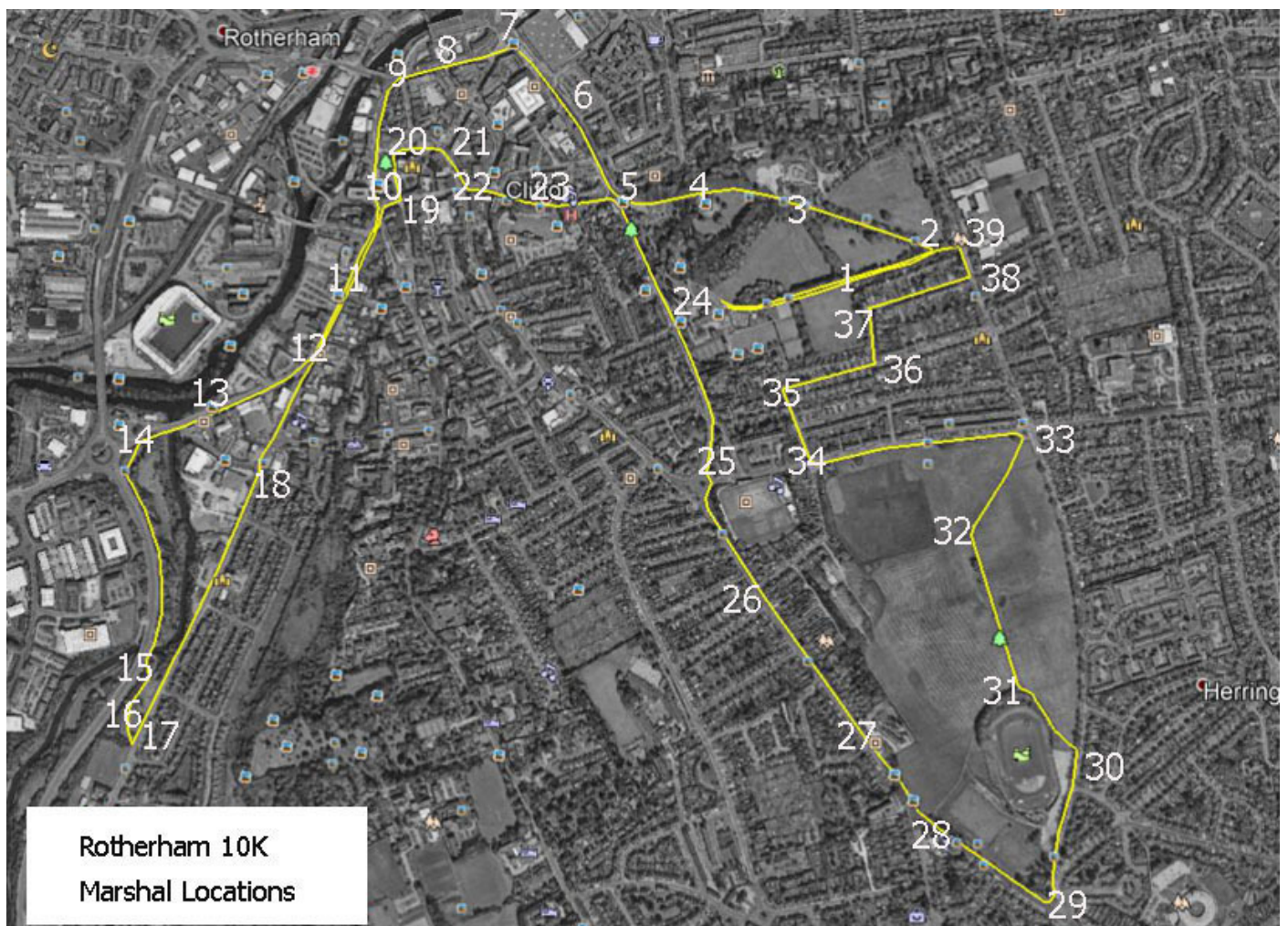
Rotherham 10K 12th May :

Volunteers needed to act as course marshals

The 2019 event starts at 11am, and the club are again seeking volunteers to act as course marshals. The event needs a total of around 40 marshals to make sure that runners are safe and correctly routed. The management of the course is achieved by dividing the route up into 4 sections, with those sections being co-ordinated by sector lead marshals.

The sectors in 2018 were:-

- Clifton park (Marshals 1 - 5) and the streets adjacent to the park (Marshals 34 -39) (Marshalled by the Rotary Clubs)
- The town centre (Marshals 6 - 10 & 19 -23) marshalled by Kimberworth Striders
- Westgate & Canklow (Marshals 11-18) - marshalled by Maltby RC.
- Clifton Lane, Broom Road & Herringthorpe (marshals 24 - 33) - marshalled by Rotherham Harriers.



All the route is on closed roads, with Traffic Management being done by a professional TM company.

The marshal role is to ensure that all runners are routed correctly, to notify the sector lead of any issues with Road closures / traffic problems - so these can be referred to the TM company, and to ensure First aid are made aware of any issues with any competitors, that requires a first aid response.

Peter Neal has again agreed to act as the sector lead for the Rotherham harriers section.

If you are able to help please confirm via a reply on Facebook or let Steve Gaines know. Marshals will be needed from 10:00 until about 13:00 for the 10K. (The marshals in the Park will be needed from 09:00 for the one lap fun run which precedes the 10K).

We need to get more volunteers than the 40 minimum needed, & we - as a club - may have to cover a wider area in 2019 so if you can help please do so!

A full briefing will be given to all who volunteer.
