There was another big KMR field for the Maltby Abbey Dash on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, the fifth event of the series and again a great evening for all concerned, with a fine race and top social after at the Catholic Club.

Also a wide spread of South Yorkshire and neighbouring clubs with Clowne and Killamarsh prominent near the front. However it was Rotherham Harriers who took the major honours with Ben Hague and Cathy Eddison winning the men's and ladies' race. Each of them established an early lead and outpaced the opposition by over two minutes over the challenging trail course around Roche Abbey.
